Very important to remember!

- Tie the bag well - **DOUBLE KNOT**
- **BLUE** bags for plastic packaging
- **GREEN** bags for food waste
- **INSIDE OUT** usual carrier bag for leftover waste
- Do not place the waste loosely in the bin
- Do not use blue and green bags for items other than plastic packaging and food waste

Also remember to sort glass and metal, paper, hazardous waste, EE waste, clothes and shoes as before.















































































